## USCIS EXPANDS PARTNERSHIP WITH SOCIAL SECURITY ADMINISTRATION A NEW WAY TO APPLY FOR A SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER

WITH YOUR USCIS APPLICATION

U.S. Citizenship Immigration Services (USCIS) recently announced that applicants for lawful permanent resident, or green card status are now able to apply for a Social Security number (SSN) or replacement card when filing a Form I-485, Application to Register Permanent Residence or Adjust Status.<sup>1</sup> Once the application is approved, USCIS will send the request electronically to the Social Security Administration (SSA), which will then assign a number and issue a new card by mail or send a replacement card directly to the applicant at the address listed on the form.

This change continues USCIS's partnership with the SSA, which previously saw an update to Form I-765, Application for Employment Authorization, that enabled applicants to simultaneously apply for work authorization and an SSN in October 2017.<sup>2</sup>

An SSN is required to work, collect social security benefits, and receive other government services. Some states will issue a driver's license without a social security number. An SSN is not required to register for school, obtain private health insurance, or apply for school lunch programs or subsidized housing.<sup>3</sup>
